members of society - citizens of the world

others – other people, other individuals

believe – think, feel

school - teachers

place to learn – location for learning

### Answer

A debate exists around whose responsibility it is to educate children in how to behave and be good citizens of the world. Whilst some people argue that this tasks lies with the parents, others maintain that they should be taught about this at school. This essay will discuss both points of view and then give the writer's opinion.

It is thought by some that 'education begins at home' and teaching good behaviour is the responsibility of the parents or primary carers. Firstly, this might be argued because in most cases it is the parents who have brought the children into this world and therefore, they should be the ones to discipline and teach their children to be decent, well-mannered individuals. Secondly, although youngsters spend a lot of time at school, the majority of their time is spent at home, and so, parents have more time in which to teach them vital social skills.

On the other side of the debate are those who feel it is the school's responsibility to educate pupils to be good members of a community. One reason for such a belief is that teachers are better qualified to instil such qualities in children for they are trained in how to do this. Moreover, it is believed that this is their job; it is what they are paid to do, as school has never been just about gaining information but rather learning how to function successfully in society.

In conclusion, it is clear there are arguments for both sides. However, school is a place that should be dedicated to learning and teachers should not have to deal with behavioural issues – children should have already learned respect for others from their parents.
