Example essay

As part of modern day society, it is no longer unusual to see men looking after the children at home and women going out to earn money. There are a number of explanations for this move away from traditional gender roles and these will be discussed in this essay along with an explanation as to why surely, this can only be a positive development for everyone.

There are perhaps two main reasons for this transformation. The first reason is that, unlike in the past, both men and women are now educated and so, they have the same chance of gaining a well-paid job. It might then be that the mother has a higher paid career than the father and so, logically, the mother should continue working. Secondly, there are no longer society's traditional expectations of fixed gender roles. In the past, men had to be the 'breadwinner' and it was frowned upon if they were not. Nowadays, it is much more acceptable for roles to be shared.

This change in views is undoubtedly only a positive thing. Firstly, if children are learning at home that their parents' roles are shared as opposed to fixed like in the past, then in the future they will also have this more balanced view. Consequently, this should lead to equality between men and women, something that has been sought for centuries but which still has not been achieved in many parts of the world.

In conclusion, it is clear people's views on gender roles are changing and the 'traditional' roles of men and women are finally fading. This reflects a modern society that promotes the equal rights of both genders. (274 words)
